

Message to the Riders of Equality Line Horse Show, Nordic Development Tour 2011!

Welcome!

Please read this message carefully, in order to make everything run smoothly it is important that all contestants have taken part of the information.

BOARDING

Boarding will commence from Wednesday at noon. If you wish to arrive early please contact the stable chief with your request, telephone +46 76 319 15 08.

Two bales of shavings are included in the Meeting price.

Feed such as hay can be ordered from an external partner Toleruds Foders, call +46 70 546 6290 to make arrangements.

Please respect the welfare of the horses and do not arrive after 22.00 on Wednesday. There will be one stable area on the show ground. That stable area will be fenced and guarded, and an access pass is needed to be allowed to enter the area. All horses in that area must fulfill the requirements of the FEI, there must be proof of vaccination and a medical log book or equivalent to it. CSI stable is closed during the night to ensure horses rest, between 23.00 and 06.00. Entering the stable during this period is possible but has to be justified in agreement with night control. Horses are not allowed to leave the stables during those hours. Please contact Show Secretary Anna Löwåker if you have questions regarding this. +46 76 319 15 08.

Then follow instructions and signs on the show ground.

Smoking in stable is strictly forbidden. Any offences will immediately lead to sanction as per OC and Ground Jury decision.

Dogs must be on a leash on the show ground, especially near the stable areas. Due to security reasons strollers and baby carriages will not be allowed in the stable areas.

TRAINING AREA

Obstacles: pool's and stands will be available 1 hour before the first class in the CSI warmup arena, the Fibersand part of Sjöbanan. If you need additional training sessions please contact Chief Steward beforehand.

Hästviksbanan (fibersand by the water) is available to CSI horses for flatwork. Other arenas are dedicated for horses in regional classes. Lunging at the small area of grass south of fibersand of the sjöbanan.

PARKING OF LORRIES

There will be plenty of lorries entering the show ground so it is very important to follow the parking attendants directives and information. You must leave a contact name and cell phone number to each vehicle.

The electricity fee must be paid for before you are allowed to park. If you have not paid in advance we can not guarantee you a spot for electricity. You will have the opportunity to pay to the parking attendant or in the show office. If you pay to the parking attendant you must pay in cash. (625 SEK)

START

Participants in the Nordic Development Tour must let the show office know which classes he/she plans to start.

All changes must be submitted to the show office by 18.00 at the latest the day before.

OBS! Nations Cup is canceled because of few Junior riders who had entered the show!

ENTRY TO FINALS

Riders who have qualified to a final are obligated to enter or withdraw their participation. This is to give the next rider in line a chance to compete if the qualified rider do not wish to start.

Entry fees as well as other international fees will be paid in the show office, and must be paid before the first start. If we are forced to send an invoice an additional charge of 150 SEK will occur.

Tied placements will share the price awards. Price awards will be paid to the riders bank account. **IMPORTANT – you must leave your account information in the show office before departure.**

RIDERS BANQUET

On Friday night a Rider's banquet is arranged in the stenmagasinet on the show ground. The night will offer a nice meal, live music.

Tickets can be purchased in the show restaurants and cost 200 SEK / person.

SHOW

Fonzie the Pony Show will make a performance on Saturday between class 13 and class 4, and on Sunday between class 16 and class 7 The location will be the fiber sand arena of Hästviksbanan.

ENTRY TO THE SHOW GROUND FOR RIDERS

Each international and regional rider will be given three entry passes for the first horse, additional horses will receive two entry passes per horse.

You will get the entry pass in the show office on arrival, and it will be valid the entire show week.

The riders will carry the responsibility to make sure that any potential horse owner will be given an entry pass. Additional entry passes can be purchased in the show office for 150 SEK for the entire week. The parking attendants will not let anyone through

that does not have an entry pass.

HORSE INSPECTION

FEI Veterinary Delegate: Roland Werner

For the international horses the veterinary inspection cost is covered in the meeting price.

International horses:

The Horse Inspection will take place on Thursday at 14.00 -17.00 south end of the fibersand of sjöbanan,

Horses shall be presented with bridle and Horse number. Please bring horse passport with you. All CSI and CSIJ horses are to be presented at the Horse Inspection.

After the horse inspection the international stable area will be closed and guarded, and no uninspected horse will be allowed entry.

The cost of the horse inspection is included in the meeting price. Please note! Mind the FEI guidelines regarding vaccination and medical log book or equivalent to it. Please read more in the Checklist Schedule. Only horses that fulfill these requirements will be allowed to be stabled in the international area.
